Since this is part of the shared curriculum for year 12 students, the course has students from Taree and even Wingham high schools.

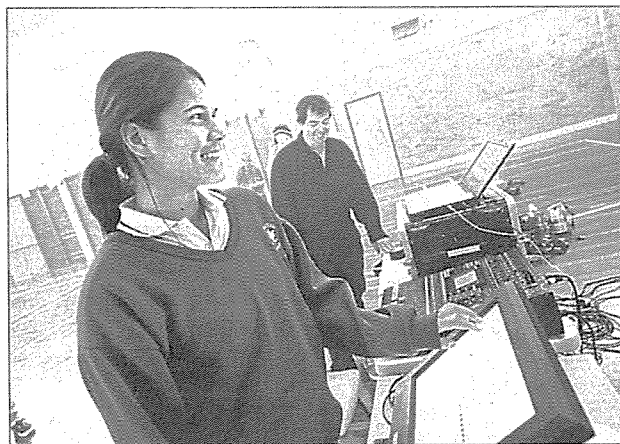
I don't know how they manage to do some of the simplest of things when there are so many wires and buttons everywhere - it looks very complicated.



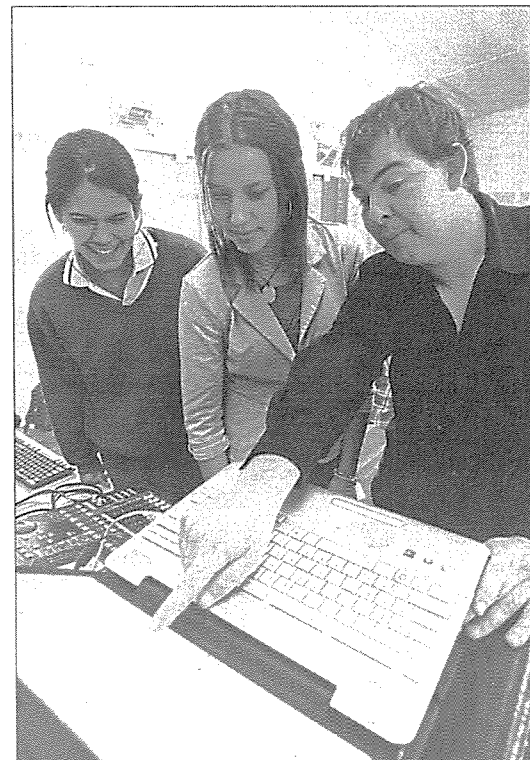

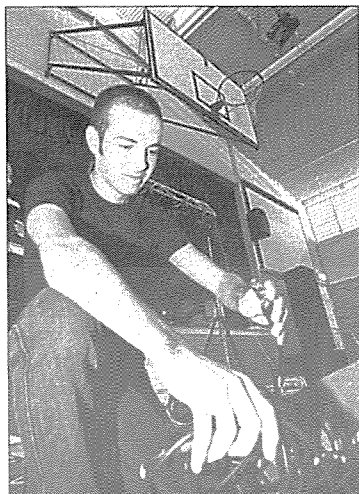
