The event is held at Chatham High School from 9.10am to midday and will cater for 1000 Year 11 and 12 students.

Sixty two tertiary and training institutions including 16 universities from two states and one territory will combine under one roof to offer advice to prospective 2014 students.

The event is timed to coincide with the opening of University Admission Centre applications," said Glen Bowman, careers adviser at Taree High School. The day is organised by ca-reers advisers from local schools and sponsored by the NSW Department of Education and Training and the Manning River Times.
